



## The Spectrum Active Advantage Fund Update

### Fund Commentary

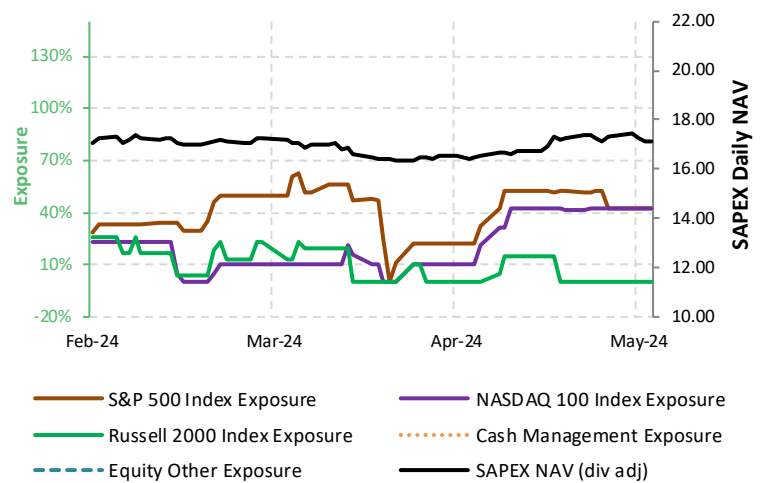
May began with positive technical undercurrents, broadening breadth that helped to lift equities. By mid-month, various overbought readings and overly optimistic sentiment gave way to weaker momentum. Mid and small caps showed the first signs of repealing some of the earlier gains with the large caps holding on to gains until a mild give back late in the month. On a positive note, trends were strong enough for the S&P 500 and NASDAQ 100 to set new 52-week highs in May. Spectrum Active Advantage (SAPEX) shifted from lower exposure in April to higher exposure at a rapid rate in early May, focusing on large caps while having a few tactical trades in mid and small cap and some sectors such as semiconductors and gold stocks. Other tactical trades took place in theme/style specific areas such as large cap growth, low volatility, and momentum among others. These were mostly overlay trades, augmenting a more trend-following focus on core holdings in the S&P 500 and NASDAQ 100. As June begins, SAPEX's management will be monitoring the status of trends as they relate to major indexes and sectors as well as technical measures that may affect possible sensitivity to volatility (beta).

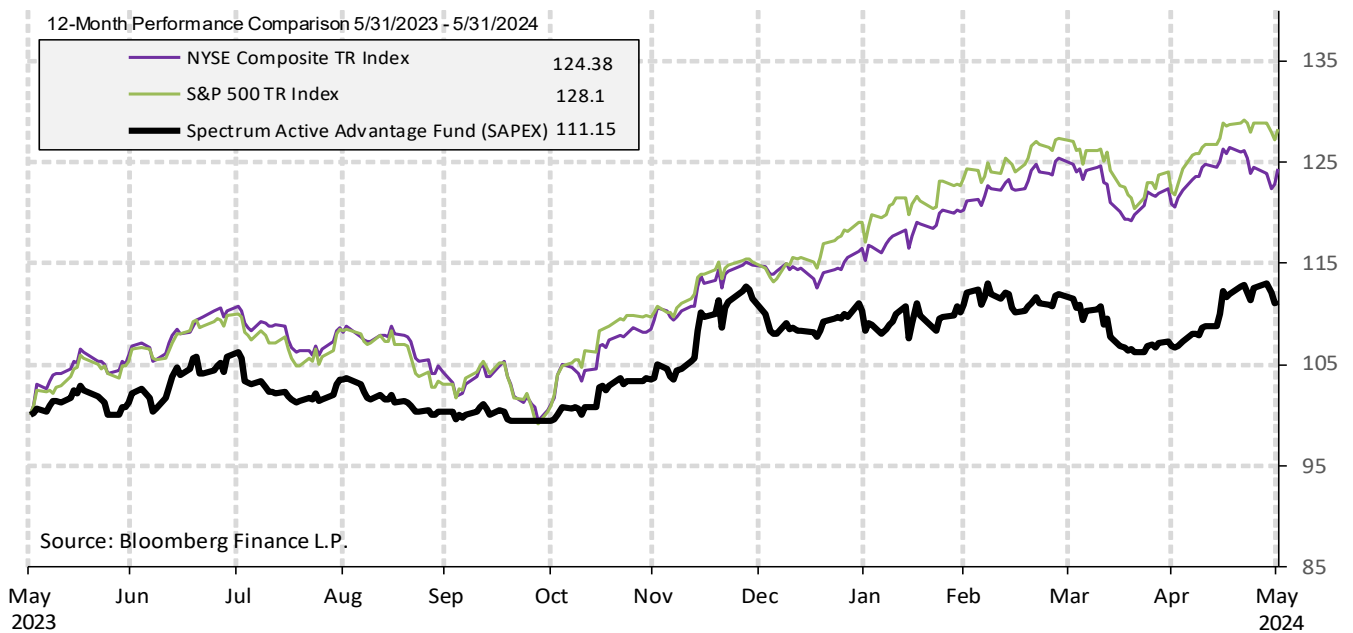
