



## The Spectrum Active Advantage Fund Update

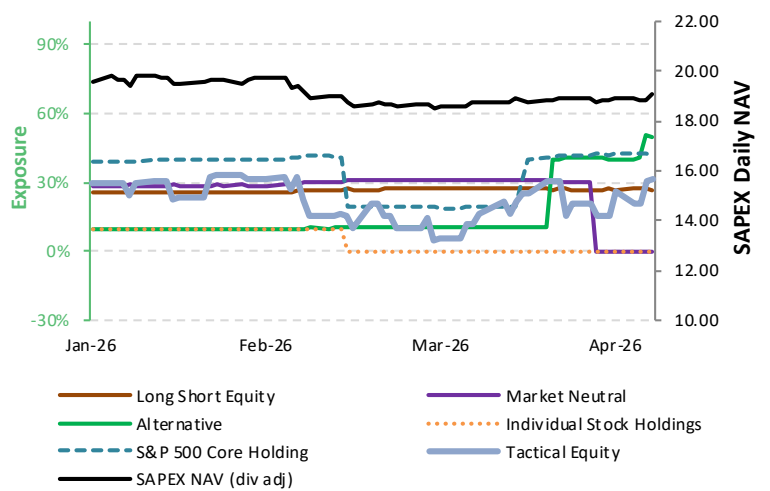
### Fund Commentary

Major U.S. equity markets posted strong gains in April as investors expressed optimism toward resiliency in economic data and progress in the Middle East conflict. At the beginning of the month, the major indexes were below key technical levels. Momentum improved, which allowed the S&P 500 and NASDAQ 100 indexes to climb back above their 200-day moving averages. By mid-month, along with the Mid-Cap 400 and Russell 200 Small-Cap indexes, the S&P 500 and NASDAQ 100 recovered above their 50-day moving averages. As technically defined risks abated, positions were added in the Spectrum Active Advantage Fund (SAPEX). However, the defensive stance at the beginning of the month, warranted at the time by Fund management, had SAPEX lagging in returns.

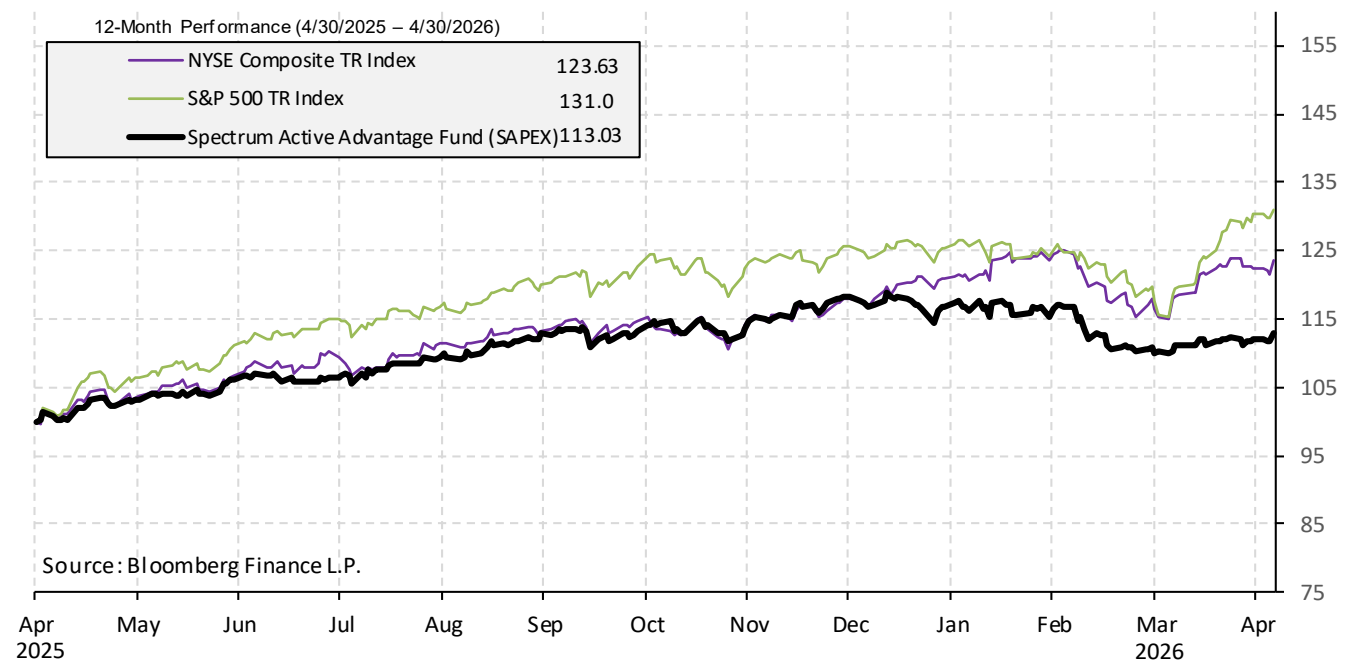
